

Camp Host

The Camp Host provides the necessary care and maintenance of the camp facilities, equipment and assists in the needs of the Summer Staff.

1. Camp Sawtooth is a Christian Camp. Conduct and attitude of the Camp Host will reflect the camp's mission. As Jesus Christ is our Teacher and role model, the Camp Host/s are teachers & role models to the Campers and representatives of Camp Sawtooth.
2. The Camp Host volunteers for weekly increments during the resident camp schedule
3. Daily: raise and lower flag each morning & evening and as inclement weather requires.
4. Daily: build a fire in Hawley Lodge fireplace each morning prior to the 7am Staff meeting.
5. Restock firewood in Hawley Lodge as needed.
6. Cut down kitchen boxes and put in dumpster.
7. Replace burned out light bulbs
8. Produce wood name tags for resident campers.
9. May be asked to run errands for the Camp Cook.
10. Makes repairs as needed, and as skill allows, as requested by the Director/s and Buildings & Grounds Committee.
11. Oversee work of outside professional help as required for repairs or improvements.
12. If the Camp Host wishes to participate in off campus camp activities such as rafting, swimming, etc. he/she may do so at their own expense as long as it does not interfere with the fulfillment of their duties as Camp Host.
13. Other duties may be added or re-assigned as deemed necessary by the Camp Director/s and/or the camp Board.
14. The Camp Host is under the supervision and management of the Camp Director/s.

The Camp Host will be provided:

1. Electrical and water hook-ups for their own camper or a room in a Popma Cabin.
2. All meals
3. \$75 per week of service or one campership for their own child.
4. The Camp Host is covered by the camp's liability and workman's compensation insurance
