

## **Camp Sawtooth –PROGRAM STAFF-IN-TRAINING (PSIT) – A Volunteer Position**

**The purpose of the Program Staff-In-Training (PSIT) program is to enable young persons to grow in Christian faith and leadership, and these while serving in the ministry of Camp Sawtooth.**

### **Brief outline of Program Staff-in- Training (PSIT) Responsibilities:**

1. PSITs are expected to attend a training and information meeting at 2:30 p.m. on Sunday, the first day of camp.
2. The PSIT will serve in cooperation with and under the direct supervision of the assigned Cabin Counselor and Program Staff Counselor.
3. The PSIT will assist the Cabin Counselor and PS Counselor in managing the weekly duties.
4. The PSIT will assist others as directed by the assigned Cabin Counselor and PS Counselor.
5. The PSIT is not a camper, but a mentor and should work in a cooperative and Christian manner with the campers.
6. The PSIT shall not be the only designated Counselor in a cabin.
7. There is a maximum of one CIT per cabin. Seven total; 3 male and 4 female.
8. The PSIT will participate in all program activities and meals

### **Requirements:**

1. The PSIT applicant **must complete** a PSIT Application Form. Include and payment, send to the below address.
2. The PSIT will be charged one-half of the camp registration fee.
3. 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Camp: Cabin Parent & Co-Cabin Parent only  
9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> Camp: Entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade or older  
Junior High Camp: Entering 11<sup>th</sup> grade or older  
5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Camp: Entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade or older  
3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> Grade Camp: Entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade or older
